Prize award

In 2021, in its third iteration, the Adam Kilgarriff Prize was awarded to Prof. Pilar León Araúz (University of Granada) for her EcoLexicon project. EcoLexicon is a multilingual terminological resource in the field of environmental science, but it is far more than just a dictionary and corpus. It is a rich resource which builds on existing technologies and extends them in really interesting ways, notably in the use of Semantic Sketch Grammars. It has great potential value for users involved in both text understanding and text generation (including translators and environmental scientists). Pilar's impressive project stood out among the 16 applications we received this year.
